Regional Bobcat Innovation Launch Pad Competition. FSU, in partnership with the TEDCO (Maryland Technology Development Corporation) Maryland Innovation Initiative (MII) and the University System of Maryland (USM) Launch Fund, will host a regional Bobcat Innovation Launch Pad competition on the FSU campus on Friday, Sept. 22, through Sunday, Sept. 24. The focus of this year's Bobcat Innovation Launch Pad will be on distributed energy resources, virtual power plants, climate change, and environmental, social and governance factors.

The Bobcat Innovation Launch Pad is a unique program that will combine the best aspects of a hackathon with those of a business pitch competition, providing teams with an opportunity to work quickly and collectively to develop business models and technology-based solutions to real-world problems.

Multidisciplinary teams consisting of four to five student members, advised and mentored by FSU faculty, staff and subject matter experts, will put their technical and entrepreneurial skills to the test as they work through problem statements related to this year's themes and conduct market research to create a commercially viable solution and subsequent new technologies to solve difficult issues.

Winning teams placing first through third will be awarded cash funding in amounts of \$2,500, \$1,500 and \$1,000, respectively, to support further exploration and development of their solution. The Bobcat Innovation Launch Pad competition is open to all students in any undergraduate or graduate degree program. While an engineering or coding background is not required, participants should be curious and highly collaborative, with the ability to utilize critical reasoning skills to work within a multi-disciplinary team.

There is no cost to attend the event, but to participate, students must apply online by **Friday, Sept. 15, at 5 p.m.** Lunch and snacks will be provided. Space is limited, so visit https://www.frostburg.edu/competitions/bobcat-innovation-launch-pad/2023.php to apply.
