Census Numbers. Our fall undergraduate enrollment census numbers were lower than hoped for. Our graduate enrollment numbers showed another year of increase with much of that attributed to online programming. Another bright spot was undergraduate retention. We saw retention increases at all undergraduate levels compared with last year. We had hoped for a total headcount of 4270. Our headcount at census was 4068. As I mentioned in the State of the University address last week, we have a target of over 4600 students for next fall. We are forming a strategic enrollment council to keep us on track for that goal, an ambitious but achievable goal.

Nursing Programs. Congratulations to the Nursing faculty and the leadership in Academic Affairs and CLAS for successfully navigating two new programs. MHEC approved both a 4-year on-campus nursing program and an online LPN to BSN program. We will be submitting these programs for review by the state board of nursing and preparing to recruit students into both programs.

PA Program. Congrats also to our PA students who won a "jeopardy-like" contest on medical knowledge featuring seven other PA programs (including all Maryland programs) this past week in Ocean City.

Homecoming. Homecoming is two weeks away. I hope everyone is planning on enjoying the many events and welcoming many alumni(ae) back to campus. More info on the events can be found on our website.
