MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Between

Frostburg State University (FSU)

And

Allegany County Public Schools (ACPS)

PROGRAM

This Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) establishes an articulation agreement between Frostburg State University (FSU) and Allegany County Public Schools (ACPS) for the PTECH program. The agreement pertains explicitly to students completing the IT Networking Academy (CISCO) offered exclusively at the ACPS Center for Career and Technical Education (CCTE).

ELIGIBLE CREDIT THROUGH ARTICULATION

Students will be eligible to receive up to sixteen (16) articulated college credits for the courses listed below. The articulated credits may be applied toward graduation requirements for relevant degree programs at FSU, such as Computer Science, Information Technology, or Cybersecurity.

ADDITIONAL PROVISIONS

1. Eligibility Criteria:

- Students must complete the entire IT Networking Academy program at CCTE.
- Students must maintain a minimum program grade of 'B.'
- All individual classes must be passed with a 'C' or better grade.
- Successful completion of specific certification exams (e.g., A+, CCNA) is required.

2. Application Process:

 Students must ensure their ACPS transcripts are submitted to FSU for evaluation to claim articulated credits.

- Articulated credits will be posted to the official FSU transcript once all required documentation has been received and processed.
- o If articulated credits appear on the Allegany College of Maryland (ACM) transcript, they can also be carried over to FSU through articulated credit, supporting the 2+2+2 program and ensuring proper validation.

3. Credit Transfer Details:

- o GPA from articulated credits will not carry over to FSU.
- o Each class will be labeled as "articulated credit" on the FSU transcript.
- Other institutions may not recognize articulated credits if a student decides to transfer from FSU.

4. Amendment or Discontinuation:

o This agreement can be amended or discontinued at any time by either party with adequate notice to avoid hindering students' educational plans.

BENEFITS

- Credits will be posted as "articulated credit" on the official FSU transcript.
- Students will receive credit but no grade for the articulated courses.
- There will be no effect on the student's GPA at FSU.
- There will be no tuition or other charges associated with obtaining credit in this manner.
- Students may realize considerable savings on the cost of college tuition.
- This agreement supports a seamless transition for students in the PTECH 2+2+2 program (ACPS to ACM to FSU), facilitating their academic progression.
